

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Only access Los Flores Ranch Park during regular business hours
- All guests must review Park Orientation materials before using the Park
- Please sign in and out when using the Park
- NO SMOKING, OPEN FLAMES, FIREARMS, OR ALCOHOL
- Keep dogs on leash (8' maximum)
- Pick up dog waste and dispose of properly
- Bring plenty of water for you and your dog(s)
- Do not litter. Trash cans provided
- Be courteous of other trail users
- Walk or ride to the far right of the trail
- Pass others on their left side, and give a warning as you pass
- Stay on marked ranch roads/trails
- Be extra careful coming around blind curves
- Close all gates behind you
- Maintenance and law enforcement vehicles operate on the trails every day - watch out for them
- Do not harass animals or cattle
- Control your bicycle or horse
- Do not climb on trees, structures, pipes, or machinery
- Follow staff and docents' directions at all times
- Do not collect/remove plants, rocks, animals, or artifacts from the Park
- All children under the age of 18 must wear a helmet when riding bicycles [CVC 21212 (a)]
- Observe and follow all regulatory signs

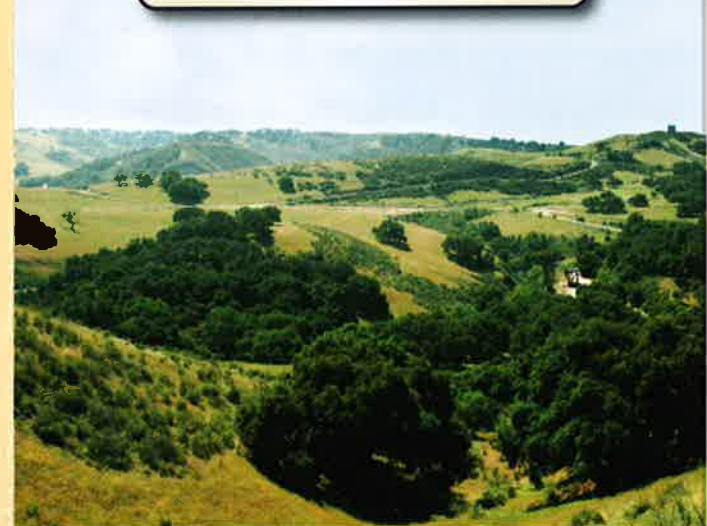
OUR MISSION
